New ADRsportRED Code of Procedure

The Sport Dispute Resolution Centre of Canada (SDRCC) has recently revised its code of procedure, taking into account the lessons learned from the past, comments made by members of the Canadian sport community and the new Canadian Anti-doping program elaborated by CCES. This new Code of procedure came into full force and effect on June 1st, 2004.

The former code of procedure ADRsportRED consequently ceased to have force and effect on the same date, except for cases which had been initiated prior to June 1st, 2004. Such cases will be completed pursuant to the former code.

The SDRCC is a not-for-profit corporation created through federal legislation and operating at arm's length from government. It administers the ADRsportRED program, offering resource materials and links to useful Internet sites focussing on dispute resolution. Where disputes cannot be prevented, the SDRCC offers out-of-court settlement options such as mediation and arbitration.
