The program features presentations and panel sessions by guest speakers, including SDRCC arbitrators, mediators, clients and collaborators. Under the theme “*Protection of Rights in Sport Dispute Resolution*”, this year’s program will address several current themes and issues in sport dispute resolution.

Fees

ADRM members	\$250	<i>Before midnight (EDT) on October 9, 2018</i>
