Profile

Professor Crowne is a [Law Professor](#) at the [University of Windsor, Faculty of Law](#), and a Barrister & Solicitor in the Province of Ontario. With over fifty (50) publications to his name, he has expertise in torts (negligence, defamation, assault, battery, etc.), contracts (drafting and interpretation), intellectual property, information technology law, gaming law, professional ethics and misconduct.

Professor Crowne has been an Appointed Member of the [Justices of the Review Peace Council](#) since 2007, and has dealt with numerous misconduct files, the education plan for Justices of the Peace, accommodation issues, and general policies and procedures relating to the conduct of Justices of the Peace. He was also a member of the Hearing Panel for a [rare] public hearing in [Re: His Worship Paul A. Welsh Justice of the Peace](#), and is the only non-judicial panel member to ever author discrete paragraphs of a judicial misconduct decision ([paras. 74 - 88](#)). He also [Chairs a Judicial Panel at the University of Windsor](#), where he deals with cases concerning academic and non-academic misconduct.
