Iñaki Gomez

A two-time Olympian, Iñaki Gomez competed at the 2012 and 2016 Olympic Games in the Men's 20km Race Walk. Iñaki holds the Canadian Record in the same distance.

Born in Mexico City, Mexico, Iñaki immigrated to Canada in 1999. He graduated from the University of British Columbia in 2011 with a Bachelor of Arts in International Relations. Between the 2012 and 2016 Olympics, Iñaki pursued a Law (J.D.) degree at the University of Calgary. Iñaki practices law at Borden Ladner Gervais LLP, Vancouver office.

Iñaki brings a vast experience in representing the athlete voice at various levels in Sport. He has served as a director on Athletics Canada's Board of Directors, as the male athlete representative, from 2014 to 2018. In 2016, he was elected to the Canadian Olympic Committee Athletes' Commission and later appointed as its Vice-Chair and an athlete representative on the Board of Directors of the COC in November 2020, and will continue in those roles until the end of 2023. At the international level, Iñaki served on World Athletics' Athletes' Commission from 2017 to 2021 and as its Chair and the athlete representative on the World Athletics Council from 2017 to 2019. In 2023, he was appointed to the World Anti-Doping Agency's Athlete Council for a term of 3 years. Iñaki also serves, and has served, on various committees, commissions, working groups and task forces at all organizations.
