

## Luc Arseneau

He graduated from the Université de Moncton with a recreation degree (1995) and he is currently continuing his career in sport in the cycling field and as a certified professional trainer. In 2001, he developed and implemented the National Cycling Center - Atlantic Canada. The Center has been a success story for this small region with more than 50 medals and national titles, more than 20 participations in World Championships plus several riders who have signed professional contracts. As a coach, Luc has participated in his 4th major Games in Beijing in 2009 (2003 Pan American Games and 2007 Paralympic Games in 2004 and 2009).

In addition to his academic studies, Luc also continues his development with the National Coaching Institute and is also a board member of Coaches of Canada. From 2004 to 2008, he was also president of the Centre for Coaching Education of New Brunswick.

Since 2001 he lives in the City of Dieppe (New Brunswick) with his wife and two sons.
