### **SDRCC Disability, Equity and Access Policy**

#### **1. Objective of the Policy**

The objective of this policy is to describe how the SDRCC promotes and guides equity and access to disabled.

#### **2. Field of application**

This policy applies to all board members, staff, arbitrators and mediators of the SDRCC.

#### **3. Provisions**

Equity and access to Canadians with a disability has always been a part of the SDRCC and is now an even larger part of our organization.

The SDRCC is committed to ensuring that all its members, be they women or men, able-bodied or disabled (physically or intellectually), have equal access to a complete range of opportunities within all aspects of the SDRCC.

The SDRCC encourages all members to participate as users or volunteer leaders, and ensures that benefits for all members shall be consistent and equal. An ongoing integration process is underway to meet the needs and programs for all members, be they able-bodied or disabled.
