## PAUL D. GODIN

Paul is a mediator, lawyer, negotiator, facilitator, trainer, and ADR systems designer exclusively with ADR Chambers. Paul teaches negotiation and contracting principles to project managers and contract managers and teaches ADR courses in Canada and internationally with the Stitt Feld Handy Group, a division of ADR Chambers. He also lectures for courses in Negotiation and ADR at the University of Toronto and the University of Windsor Law Schools.

Paul has mediated numerous commercial and civil cases, specializing in personal injury, insurance and contract disputes.

Paul articulated at Osler Hoskin & Harcourt in Toronto, then was called to the bar in 1997. He then practiced law with the Toronto litigation boutique of Rogers Moore, gaining expertise in insurance, professional liability, and personal injury litigation.

While at the University of Toronto, Paul was an International Client Counselling Competition champion, representing Canada, as well as an award winning mooter, and varsity water polo player. He also represented the University of Toronto in the American Bar Association Negotiation Competition.

Prior to law, Paul was a geologist. He obtained a B.A. in Anthropology, then a B.Sc. in Geology with High Distinction, both from the University of Toronto, followed by two years of geology post-graduate work at the University of Southern California as a NSERC 1967 Scholar. He obtained his LL.B. in 1995 from the University of Toronto, where he was on the Dean's List in his first year and earned several scholarships.

Paul has acted in numerous mediations and negotiations involving complex legal and factual issues in a variety of procedural contexts, including issues before the Ontario Superior Court of Justice, the Ontario Court of Appeal, and The Financial Services Commission of Ontario. Many of these disputes were large multi-party disputes in areas such as insurance coverage, environmental issues, personal injury, professional liability, negligence, contracts, and accident benefits. Paul is a Roster Mediator, Ontario Mandatory Mediation Program - Toronto. Paul is the author of a number of peer-reviewed publications both in law and geology, including several papers on the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms, and has written numerous articles on negotiation and mediation.
