Mediation and Arbitration Experience

Anne Sone is a lawyer who conducts arbitrations and mediations at the Financial Services Commission of Ontario (FSCO). She has conducted approximately 1,500 mediations at FSCO since 1997. In 2007, she received a Stella Award from the Ministry of Revenue. Previously, she conducted arbitrations and mediations for the Licencing Appeal Tribunal of Ontario. She has also conducted arbitrations for the Centre for Sport and Law.

In recognition of Anne's excellence in mediation, she was inducted as a Fellow of the International Academy of Mediators in April 2009. Anne lectured on the topic of *Fair Hearings* at a Federated Press Conference in Toronto, Ontario on September 29 and 30, 2010. On March 30, 2009, she lectured at an Insight Conference in Ottawa, Ontario on *Mediation in Administrative Tribunals*. Also in 2009, she was shortlisted for Insight's Alternative Dispute Resolution Award. On January 31, 2008, she lectured at a Canadian Institute Conference in Ottawa, Ontario on *Running a Fair Hearing*. She has conducted numerous training sessions for Mediators and Arbitrators at the Financial Services Commission and the Financial Services Tribunal.
